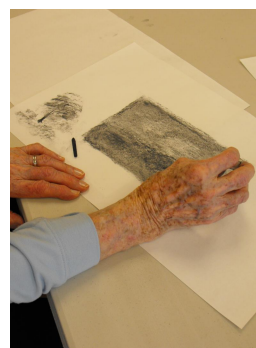
Seniors Outreach Programs

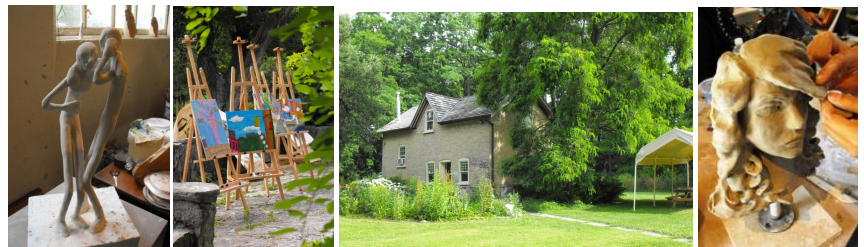
