Submission Requirements

1. Open to all Canadian citizens and residents
2. You will be required to pay an entrance fee of **\$20.00 to be paid by Cheque, Credit Card or Cash in person to Homer Watson House Foundation**. The fee will grant membership to the Gallery for a one year period.
3. Artists may submit one or two pieces of artwork
4. Only works done **after January 2018** may be submitted.
5. The required outside size is 12" x 12" for each piece.
6. Homer Watson Gallery's Commission is 40% on any sale which provides visual arts education and exhibition.
7. The content of artist's works must adhere to the theme and be derived from inspiration found in *Future Endeavours*. This may be literally or figuratively.

Quilts must be submitted with a return envelope and prepaid postage.

Entries will be selected based on the quality of the submitted piece and accompanying Artist's Statement; and according to CQA/ACC Quilting Standards and Principles of Design

Decisions of the juror and curator are final; there is no appeal process.

Winners will be announced at the Opening Reception Sunday May 5, 2019, 2-4pm

Terms of Entry

1. Quilts must be finished, clean and in good condition.
2. All entries must meet the definition of a quilt, i.e. they are made of three layers with quilting that penetrates all 3 layers and is visible on the front and back. Any technique is acceptable.
3. Each quilt **must** have hanging sleeve and rod and be without frame.
4. Quilts should feature reduced scale and miniaturization. If blocks are used, they must not measure more than 4" square. Miniature wholecloth quilts are acceptable. Quilts must measure 12" square including binding/edge finishing and be hung square (no diamond orientation please).
5. Quilts may be of original design or based on quilt blocks or patterns in the public domain. Appropriate credit must be given to designers, teachers or others who contributed to the quilt design or execution. No kits, panels or commercial patterns will be accepted.
6. Entrants will agree to have images released newspapers, magazine articles and social media to allow promotion of the exhibit, gallery and country.
7. Insurance is provided to protect the art work from vandalism and theft. A value must be given for all works submitted. In the event of a loss, verification of the value of art work will be required. All reasonable care will be exercised in handling entries while at the Homer Watson House and Gallery.
8. The gallery is not responsible for accidental damage caused by normal handling and installation.
9. Quilts must be submitted with a return packaging and prepaid postage unless otherwise agreed upon in writing to be picked-up at the gallery Monday April 15 – 18; 12:30 – 4:30. Work not picked up within one year of the exhibit will become the property of the Gallery unless a loan agreement is secured.
10. Art work must hang in the Gallery until the show is completed.
11. Homer Watson House and Gallery reserves the right of final decision on suitability of subject matter.
